The Achieve programme helps 11 to 19 year-olds to develop the skills and confidence they need to engage and succeed in education, so they can reach their full potential.

- an engaging, informal style of learning to help young people improve attainment, attendance, personal and social development and engagement with learning
- training, support and resources for your staff delivering the programme
- newly developed content specifically for young people starting secondary school
- no fee to run an Achieve club in your school or centre

On the Achieve programme, young people access a varied curriculum of engaging, relevant activities as well as enrichment opportunities and the option to work toward a **qualification in Personal Development and Employability Skills**, which is recognised by all UK regulatory authorities.

OUR CURRICULUM:

The varied Achieve curriculum can cover topics including:

- Skills for School
- Personal and Social Development
- Life Skills
- Active Citizenship
- Enterprise Projects
- Preparation for Work
- Plus enrichment opportunities in STEM, Literacy, Language and Numeracy, Arts, Sport or Employability

We have a network of **around 500 education partners** and support over **10,000 young people** in education each year. **90% of young people** improved at least one soft skill after taking part in the programme.*
